

2010 FATHER SON OVERNIGHT: REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

Dear Camper:

Congratulations! Your registration for the **2010 Ben Braun / Rice Owls Basketball Camp** at Rice University (6100 Main Street, Houston, TX 77005) has just been received! You have signed up for the following session:

Father-Son Overnight Camp from 6-9pm on Friday, June 18 and Saturday, June 19 from 9am-3pm

WHAT TO BRING: You will be staying in on campus, dormitory style suites on Friday evening. Bring: personal toiletry items, soap, shampoo, sheets (twin bed size) / blanket / sleeping bag, towels, pillow, alarm clock, clothing (shorts, socks, shirts, clothes to lounge in at night), laundry bag, spending money (if you want to purchase additional snacks, pizza, or something from the camp store). Don't bring televisions. On Friday evening in the dorms, we will have basketball movies and activities in the lounge area. Don't bring anything expensive that might get "lost." Do not bring or wear jewelry, watches, hats, etc. Additionally, do not bring a basketball, there will be plenty for use.

CAMP TIMES: Camp will run from 6-9pm on Friday, June 18 and Saturday, June 19 from 9am-3pm. See attached schedule for greater detail (times and schedule are subject to change).

CHECK-IN: Check in will take place at Sid Richardson College commons area on the campus of Rice University on Friday, June 18th from 5-6pm (see Parking/Map below for further details).

MEALS: Breakfast and lunch will be provided on Saturday. Pizza and snacks will be available on Friday evening after camp session is complete at 9pm in the lounge of the dorms.

PARKING / MAP: See the attachment regarding parking areas and map of the Rice University campus.

Entrance - Sid Richardson College (dormitory) is located at entrance #4 on the east side of campus, just south of the intersection of Main St. and S. MacGregor. We will have staff out to expedite the parking process on the first and last day of camp.

Parking -If you will require a parking pass, please email us at basketball@rice.edu. After check-in on Friday at the Sid Richardson college/dorm, fathers will be asked to drive and park their cars in West Lot #1, adjacent to Tudor Fieldhouse. Parking passes will be issued and must be returned upon camp conclusion. Camp will then begin at 6pm in Tudor Fieldhouse. After camp on Saturday, fathers will proceed to their cars and drive back to Sid Richardson college/dorm to pick up their belongings and depart campus.

CAMP TRAINER: We have a full time trainer who will be on site in the event you or your youngster is injured or feels ill during camp. Should you have any medical concerns regarding you or your youngster (diabetic, allergies, medication to be administered, etc.), please convey this to the trainer on the first day of camp. In the waiver statement that was electronically signed, please note that over-the-counter medications may be given as necessary. Should you have any questions about this policy, please speak to our camp trainer at check in. Furthermore, as a special note, campers and parents should prepare their young men to wear briefs, boxer briefs, or compression shorts to alleviate rash problems that typically occur on long, warm days of playing basketball.

VISITATION: Mothers and other family members are asked to park in **West Lot 1** (hourly charge) to observe the entire activities. Please observe camp from the bleachers above the court.

CLOSING CEREMONY/CONCLUSION OF CAMP: A **Closing Ceremony** will take place at 2:45 on Saturday, June 19th in Tudor Fieldhouse. After camp on Saturday, fathers will proceed to their cars and drive back to Sid Richardson college/dorm to pick up their belongings and depart campus.

REFUND POLICY:

- \$50 of total is considered a deposit and is non-refundable.
- No partial refunds/discounts/or prorated rates for attending other events or being able to only attend certain days.
- If camper cannot attend due to unforeseen circumstances, notification must be made *prior to the start of first day of camp*.
- Additionally, no other camper may attend in place of your son/daughter due to absence.
- If camper misses 3 or more days due to illness/injury, balance will be reimbursed minus \$50 minimum deposit (physician's note may be required).
- In the event of a dire family situation, refund will be given for day(s) missed, minus \$50 deposit.

SAFETY: Sid Richardson College dormitory is the best dorm for us to be in on campus. It is a 7-story high-rise building with one way to enter the building and one way to exit. You will be issued a key that will allow access to enter the door to the building, to use the elevator, and to enter your room (**Remember:** Our staff will be billed \$50 for each lost key. You will be held responsible for that cost). Each floor will have a camp counselor responsible for wake-up and curfew. If there is ever need for you to contact one of the hall counselors, their rooms will be clearly marked. Everyone will be provided with the camp director's room number in case of emergency. Campus police are walking campus day and night and will be fully aware of our presence on campus.
