

2010 SUPERSTAR OVERNIGHT: REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

Dear Camper:

Congratulations! Your registration for the **2010 Ben Braun / Rice Owls Basketball Camp** at Rice University, 6100 Main Street, Houston, TX 77005 has just been received! You have signed up for the following session:

Superstar Overnight Camp from 9am Check-In on Sunday, June 13 through Check-Out 5pm Wednesday, June 16.

WHAT TO BRING: You are staying on campus for 4 days and 3 nights. Bring: personal toiletry items, soap, shampoo, sheets (twin bed size) / blanket / sleeping bag, towels, pillow, alarm clock, clothing (shorts, socks, shirts, clothes to lounge in at night during concessions – good idea to have name on everything), laundry bag, spending money (if you want to purchase additional snack credits or something from the camp store). Furthermore, as a special note, campers and parents should prepare their young men to wear briefs, boxer briefs, or compression shorts to alleviate rash problems that typically occur on warm, long days of playing basketball. Do not bring or wear jewelry, watches, hats, etc. *Cell phones will be put away during camp time.* Additionally, do not bring a basketball, there will be plenty for use.

CHECK-IN: Check in will take place at Sid Richardson College commons area on the campus of Rice University on Sunday, June 13th from 9-11am (See Parking for further details).

CAMP TIMES: Camp will run from 11am (9am check-in) Sunday, June 13 to 5pm Wednesday, June 16. See attached schedule for greater detail (all times are subject to change).

MEALS: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided each day. The first meal that will be provided for camp will be Sunday Dinner and the last meal being Wednesday Lunch. On the first day of camp during registration you either need to go get a lunch for your son or pack him a lunch (*There will be pizza or sandwiches and snacks on sale at the camp store*). We will not eat dinner until about 4:45 that day.

PARKING / MAP: If your son will be driving and need a parking pass, please email us ahead of time at basketball@rice.edu. Please see the attachment regarding parking areas and map of the Rice University campus.

Entrance – Sid Richardson College (dormitory) is located at entrance #4 on the east side of campus, just south of the intersection of Main St. and S. MacGregor. We will have staff out to expedite the parking process on the first and last day of camps.

Drop off first day – You are welcome to park and stay with your youngster during registration to get them set up in their room. *Camp organizational meeting* will take place at ~11:15 am in the commons area of the Sid Richardson College dormitory. The Sid Richardson parking lot is for Rice students with parking permits only. We will only be allowed to access and use the lot during registration on the first day of camp and during the last day of camp pick up. *If your son has a car and needs to park in the Sid Richardson lot*, we will provide him with a Rice parking hang tag. Please email us ahead of time at basketball@rice.edu. *Remember:* the Rice police WILL ticket cars that are parked illegally.

Commuter Campers – You are a full member of camp and we expect you at every meeting / meal, etc. Breakfast will be served at the dorm from 7:30 – 8:30 am. We expect commuter campers to be dropped off *at the Sid Richardson College* (dormitory) by no later than 8:15 am. Commuter campers may be picked up after evening games at Tudor Fieldhouse (roughly 8:30 – 8:45 pm).

CLOSING CEREMONY/CONCLUSION OF CAMP: The *Closing Ceremony* will take place at 4:00 on Wednesday, June 16 in Tudor Fieldhouse. You are welcome to park in West Lot 1 and observe the entire last day of games / stations, or you may arrive for the closing ceremony. At roughly 4:30 – 4:45, we will dismiss the boys to head back over to Sid Richardson College dormitory to pick up their pre-packed bags and depart for home. You can drive your son over to the dorm, or he can walk and you can meet him at the dorm to pick up his bags. Brief parking will be allowed at the Sid Richardson dorm for bag pick-up. If you are not going to attend the closing ceremony, you must communicate that to your son so he knows that you will be parking at the dorm and he will meet you there after the ceremony.

CAMP TRAINER: We have a full time trainer who will be on site in the event your youngster is injured or feels ill during camp. Should you have any medical concerns regarding your youngster (diabetic, allergies, medication to be administered, etc.), please convey this to the trainer on first day of camp. In the waiver statement that was electronically signed, please note that over-the-counter medications may be given. Should you have any questions about this policy, please speak to our camp trainer at check-in. Furthermore, as a special note, campers and parents should prepare their young men to wear briefs, boxer briefs, or compression shorts to alleviate rash problems that typically occur on long days of playing basketball.

VISITATION: All family members are welcome to observe camp from the bleachers above. While you are welcome to visit your son in the dorm, it is best to limit those opportunities.

REFUND POLICY:

- \$100 of total is considered a deposit and is non-refundable.
- No partial refunds/discounts/or prorated rates for attending other events or being able to only attend certain days.
- If camper cannot attend due to unforeseen circumstances, notification must be made *prior to the start of first day of camp*.
- Additionally, no other camper may attend in place of your son/daughter due to absence.
- If camper misses 3 or more days due to illness/injury, balance will be reimbursed minus \$100 minimum deposit (physician's note may be required).
- In the event of a dire family situation, refund will be given for day(s) missed, minus \$100 deposit.
- If camper is dismissed because of drinking, smoking, drugs or if camper is dismissed for bringing intentional harm to another attendee, camper will be sent home with no refund.

CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS: Here are our 3 goals of camp: to **have fun, learn, and improve**. The purpose is for us to provide basketball instruction, drills and competition. Anything that takes us or other campers away from that objective will be addressed. We very rarely "discipline" your sons. If behavior needs to be addressed, first it will go through the camp director. The next step is to see Coach Braun, the Head Basketball Coach at Rice. Absolutely no smoking, drinking, or drugs. Offenders will be sent home immediately with no refund. All dorm and campus behavior rules will be fully covered by the camp director during our first meeting.

SAFETY: Sid Richardson College dormitory is the best dorm for us to be in on campus. It is a 7-story high-rise building with one way to enter the building and one way to exit. If this is your son's first sleep-away camp, this is a very safe way to indoctrinate him to staying away from home. Your son will be issued a key that will allow him to enter the door to the building, to use the elevator, and to enter his room. We have a very good system that we implement for your son to keep up with his key during camp (**Remember:** Our staff will be billed \$50 for each lost key. Remind your son that it will be you picking up that cost). Each floor will have at least 2 camp counselors responsible for wake-up, curfew and order. If there is ever need for your son to contact one of the hall counselors, their rooms will be clearly marked. Each camper will know CH's (camp director) room in case of emergency. Camp staff gets up before the boys and goes to sleep after the campers. We walk the halls and make sure that boys are "in rooms" at the appropriate time and that "lights are out" at the appropriate time (* The boys are usually so tired that "lights out" usually takes care of itself by the second night of camp). Campus police are walking campus day and night and will be fully aware of our presence on campus.
